All Saints', High Kelling (*in the Parish of Holt with High Kelling*)

All Saints Church, built as the chapel of Bramblewood Sanatorium in 1924, has been used for parish worship since 1955. It was established as a 'District Church' in the Parish of Holt in 1978 and in 1994 the title of the Parish and Benefice was changed to 'Holt with High Kelling'. It is licensed for weddings and the churchyard is consecrated for the burial of cremated remains. Services follow the Common Worship liturgy. To celebrate its 50th anniversary in 2005 a lychgate was provided at the entrance to the Garden of Remembrance.

St Andrew's, Holt

St Andrew's Church is a beautiful Grade 2* listed building, restored in 1727 following the great fire in Holt in 1708. William Butterfield further restored the building between 1862 and 1874.

There is much of historic interest in the main church worship areas, including the Sacrament Chapel, developed in 2002 in the space vacated by the 19th century Bryceson pipe organ. A colour brochure is available in the church to help visitors to appreciate and understand all of its main features.

REFUSE COLLECTION

All households in North Norfolk have been supplied with two 240-litre wheeled bins: **green** for recyclable materials and **black** for domestic rubbish.

The bins are collected on alternating Fridays. The bins should be wheeled to the edge of your property by **7am with the handles facing outwards**, on the day of collection.

Recycling Centres

The closest Waste & Recycling Centre is located on the A148 just after the left turns to Sheringham & Pretty Corner, in the lay-by close to Hilltop Outdoor Activity Centre.

Black Waste Bin

Use plastic sacks for your rubbish before placing in the black wheelie bin. Do not cram or stuff waste into the bins or put so much in that the lid won't close. The bin is emptied mechanically into the lorry and if rubbish is jammed in such that it won't fall out, the refuse collectors will return the bin to you full. Additional waste will not normally be taken.

Green Recycling Bin

Your recyclables should be placed loose in your green bin, not in bags. If you have more recyclables than will fit inside your bin, place them neatly inside a cardboard box or clear bag by the bin, but ensure they are secured to prevent litter.

The following can now go in your green recycling bin after being rinsed:

- Food and drink steel and aluminium cans
- Bottles and jars including lids
- Aluminium foil and trays
- Plastic food pots, tubs and trays
- Empty aerosol cans
- Plastic bottles including lids
- Paper and Cardboard
- Food and drink cartons including milk and soup containers

Brown Garden Waste Bins

WALKING IN HIGH KELLING AND LOCAL AREA

There is a footpath from All Saints' Church through Bodham Common and down to Selbrigg Pond with its resident swans. For a longer walk on the far side of the pond there is a walk to Baconsthorpe Castle.

At the Bodham end of the village there is a path on the left off the A148 into Bodham Woods, where other paths lead to the holiday park and down to Weybourne.

There are lots of walks a short drive away including Holt Country Park, Sheringham Park & Felbrigg (NT), Kelling Heath, Bayfield Estate, Muckleburgh, and of course, the Norfolk Coast Path.

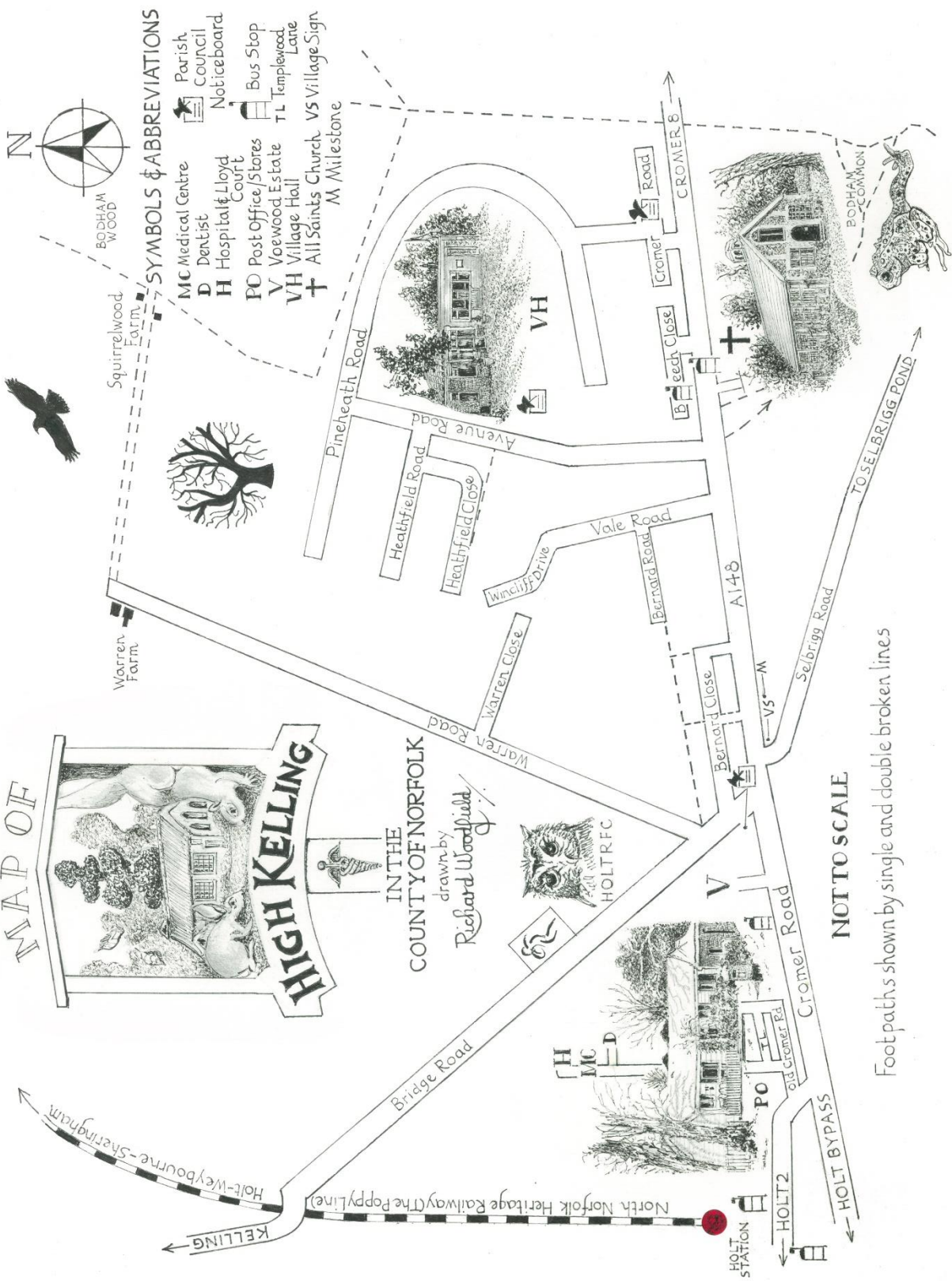
